Notice to Public of Termination of Bailey Park Community Living Center

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that Bailey Park Community Living Center has failed to substantially comply with Medicare and Medicaid health and safety participation requirements. Notice is hereby given that on **April 10, 2024**, in compliance with federal law, CMS will terminate the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Bailey Park Community Living Center, 2400 Mitchell Street, Humboldt, Tennessee 38343.

Based on Denial of Payment for New Admissions imposed on Bailey Park Community Living Center in the Imposition Notice dated December 15, 2023, CMS will not pay for skilled nursing facility services furnished to Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries admitted to Bailey Park Community Living Center on or after December 21, 2023. However, payment for services rendered to beneficiaries admitted before December 21, 2023, may continue for up to 30 calendar days after **April 10, 2024**.

While we understand the relocation of residents can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes resident safety and care quality. We are closely monitoring the relocation of residents to other facilities.
