Notice to Public of Termination of Douglas Post-Acute and Rehabilitation Center

Notice is hereby given that on April 4, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and **Douglas Post-Acute and Rehabilitation Center (2084 West Main Street, Milan, Tennessee)**. CMS has determined that Douglas Post-Acute and Rehabilitation Center has failed to substantially comply with Medicare and Medicaid health and safety participation requirements.

Douglas Post-Acute and Rehabilitation Center has previously been notified that CMS will not pay for skilled nursing facility services furnished to Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries admitted to Douglas Post-Acute and Rehabilitation Center after October 8, 2022. As specified in this notice, all payments for services furnished to Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries will cease on April 4, 2023. However, payment for services rendered to beneficiaries admitted on or before October 8, 2022, may continue for up to 30 calendar days after April 4, 2023.

While we understand the relocation of residents can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes resident safety and care quality. We are closely monitoring the relocation of residents to other facilities.
