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**Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public**

Notice is hereby given that on April 18, 2024, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Remarkable Healthcare of Fort Worth, Fort Worth, Texas as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, as authorized by the Texas State Medicaid Agency, notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective April 18, 2024.

CMS has determined that Remarkable Healthcare of Fort Worth has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements:

- 483.10(a)(1)(2)(b)(1)(2) -- Resident Rights/Exercise of Rights
- 483.10(g)(14)(i)-(iv)(15) -- Notify of Changes (injury/decline/room, etc.)
- 483.25 -- Quality of Care
- 483.45(a)(b)(1)-(3) -- Pharmacy Services/Procedures/Pharmacist/Records

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after March 2, 2024. For Medicare residents admitted prior to March 2, 2024, payment may continue for up to 30 days of services on or after April 18, 2024, the date of termination.

In addition, Medicaid Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after March 2, 2024. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to March 2, 2024, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to eligible residents furnished on or after April 18, 2024, the date of termination.
